There weren't any overhead drawings in the attachment - so we can't see what access to/from 10th would stay or be eliminated.

How will they manage flooding in the depressed road section? Last Friday reminded us what a mess it could turn into.

What became of the elevated roadway concept that incorporated full FL Turnpike access?

How will these concepts navigate the CSX rails? Will everything get squeezed at the Military Trail interchange?

How will these concept navigate the SW 12th interchange just east of the CSX rails?

What became of the argument that this was not possible as DRF water mains run under 10th St.?? Was that information incorrect?


