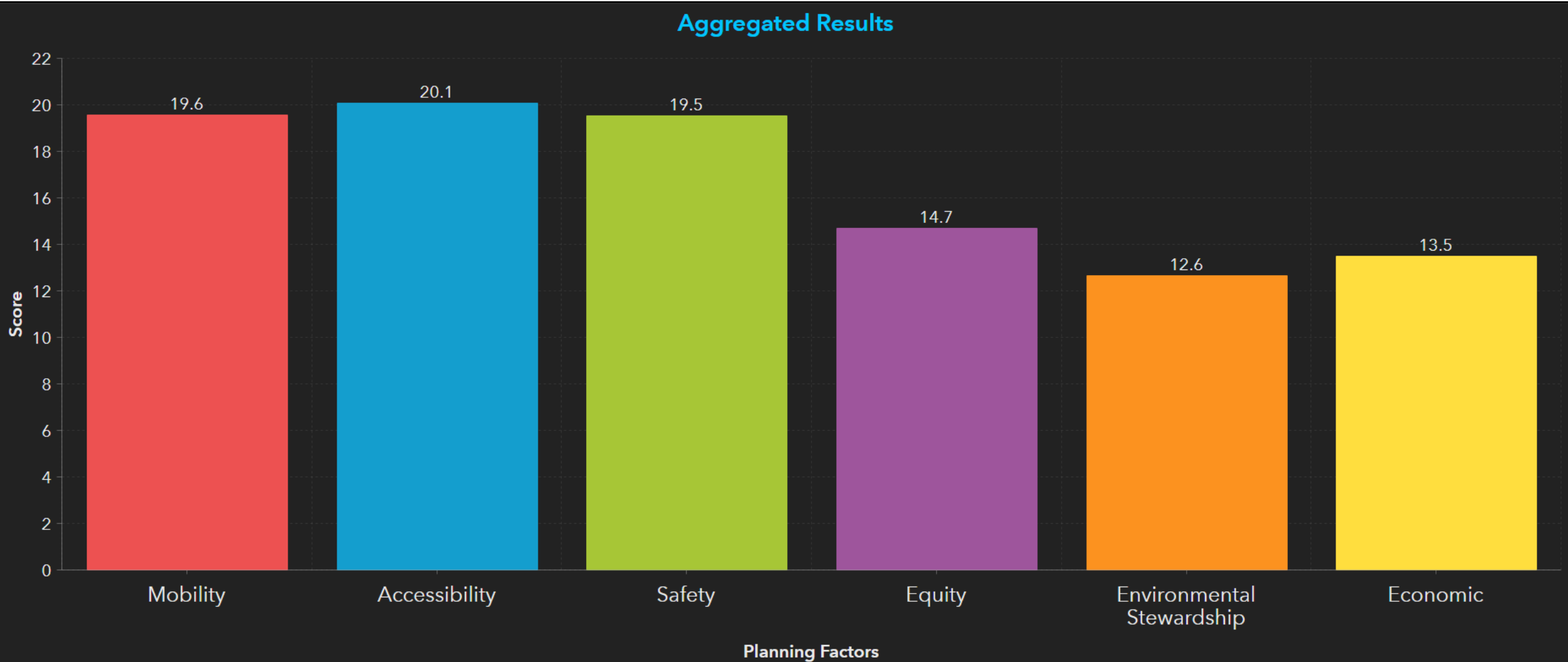

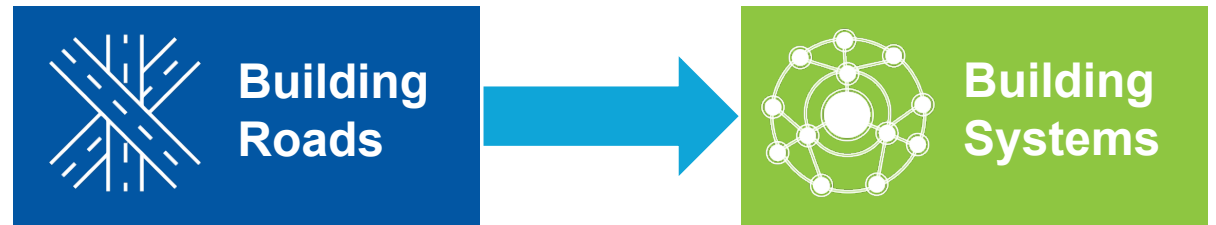
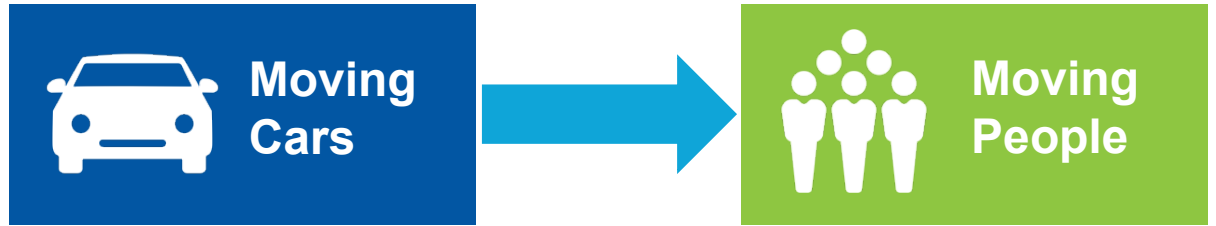

NEEDS ASSESSMENT – PROJECT PRIORITIZATION

- Project Prioritization is underway
- Identifying existing projects in Work Program to carry forward to the MTP
- Expectation to have a draft list of prioritized project by next FTAC meeting (April 2019)



NEEDS ASSESSMENT – SURTAX

- County Transportation Surtax passed Nov. 6th
- \$15.6B in revenues over 30 years
- Surtax includes allocation for municipal transportation projects
- Broward MPO responsible for prioritizing municipal projects
- 26 miles of light rail alignment to be determined by Broward MPO working with partners



How will the Broward MPO Incorporate the County Surtax?

The approach to developing the Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan currently focuses on assigning cost-feasible projects into one of six funding programs – Highway, Transportation Systems Management & Operations (TSM&O) and Safety, Transit, Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP), Mobility Hubs, and Complete Streets Master Plan (CSMP). With the successful vote for the County Surtax we will add a new funding program to prioritize the 10% County Surtax for Local Projects.

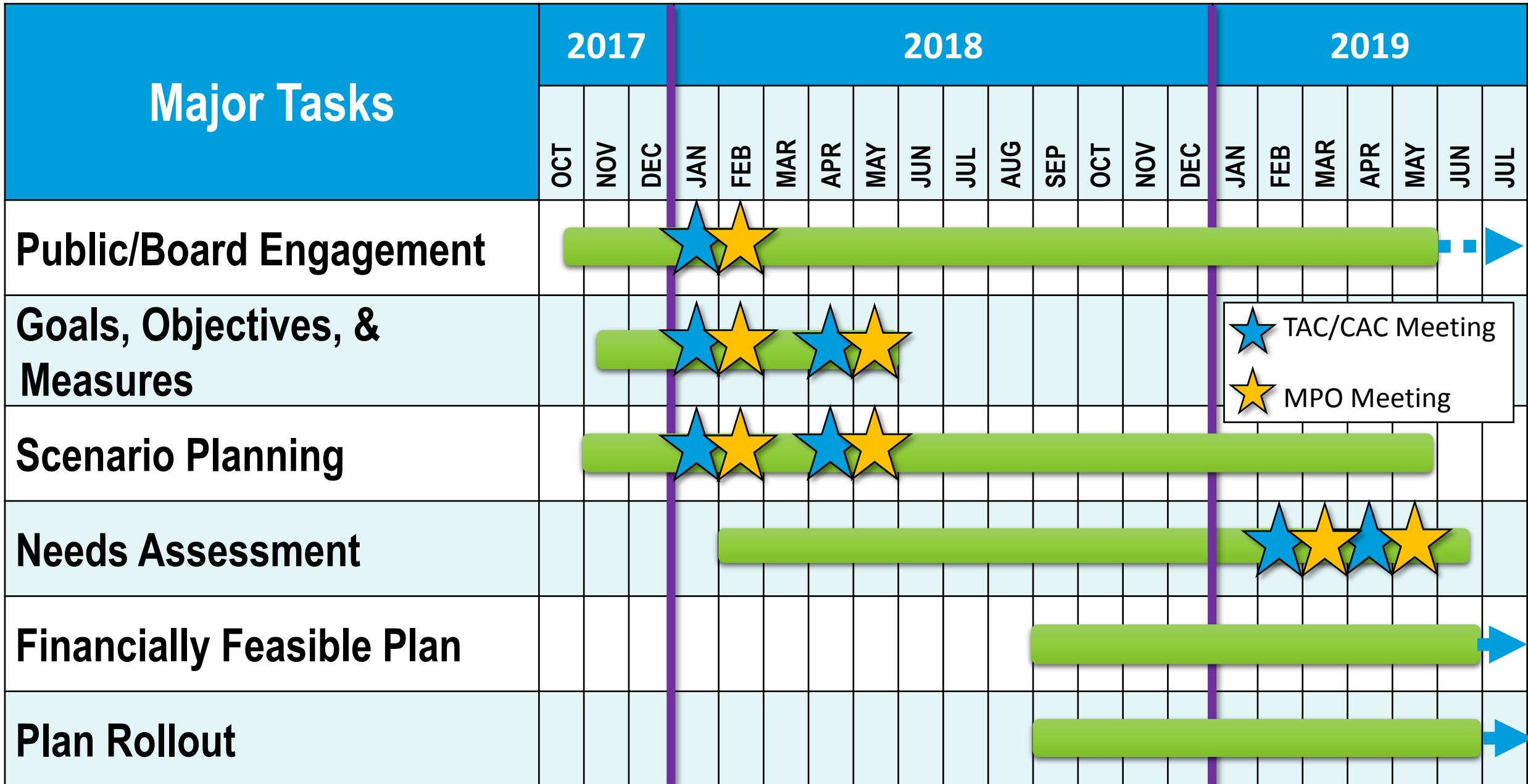


NEXT STEPS
