Needs Assessment Outreach Tool

Purpose: The intent of this initial step of the Needs Assessment is to provide each municipality within Broward County the opportunity to: (1) review and, if necessary, correct project descriptions published within the current Long Range Transportation Plan - *Transformation 2035* for all projects within the municipality's jurisdiction; (2) provide feedback / comments regarding these projects; (3) if necessary, provide a list of additional projects needed but not included within *Transformation 2035* ; and, (4) provide a Purpose and Need statement for each project that the municipality plans to construct.

Step 1: Provide your contact information, including name, title, department, phone number and email address (column "B" within worksheet "Step-1" with input cells highlighted light grey). Additional space is included for suggestions or general comments.

Step 2: Review list of projects, located within your municipality, published within the current Long Range Transportation Plan - *Transformation 2035* (columns "B" through "X" within worksheet "Step-2") and, if necessary, provide or correct the project description (column "G" within worksheet "Step-2") as well as provide additional feedback and comments regarding these projects (columns "Y" through "AD" within worksheet "Step-2" with input cells highlighted light grey). A hyperlink to an *Interactive Mapping Tool* providing a graphic representation of each project is included in column "M" (see worksheet "Resource-Map").

Step 3: If necessary, provide a list of projects that are *NOT* published within *Transformation 2035* but needed improve to our transportation system. Provide basic information regarding these projects (columns "A" through "O" within worksheet "Step-3). These projects will be evaluated for merit and potential funding opportunities during the development of the financially feasible 2040 plan.

Purpose & Need Guidance

Needs Assessment Outreach Tool

Example Purpose and Needs Statement: The *Central Broward East-West Project* will implement premium transit service (a mix of streetcar and bus rapid transit) in Central Broward, with the goal to connect the western portions of the County with downtown Fort Lauderdale and the Airport. This service will improve the ability to get to places faster in the central part of Broward County. This service will improve the ability of residents and workers to get to places faster and support economic growth and development along the corridor. Furthermore, providing a premium transit service will get more people out of their cars, which will lead to reduced congestion and vehicle emissions.

State Considerations: The *2060 Florida Transportation Plan (FTP)* developed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) identified several goals and objectives that implementing agencies should consider, when applicable, when developing purpose and need statements, including (1) invest in transportation systems to support a prosperous, globally competitive economy; (2) make transportation decisions to support and enhance livable communities; (3) make transportation decisions to promote responsible environmental stewardship; (4) provide a safe and secure transportation system for all users; (5) improve mobility and connectivity for people and freight.

Local Considerations: A review of 22 available local comprehensive plans in Broward County identified the following considerations implementing agencies should consider, when applicable, when developing purpose and need statements, including (1) develop and maintain a transportation system that meets the needs of all sectors of the community in a safe, efficient, cost effective and aesthetically pleasing manner; (2) reduce accident rates on roadways; (3) maintain current hurricane evacuation times; (4) ensure adequate maintenance funding; (5) meet all adopted Level-of-Service standards; (6) incorporate access management practices into all roadway design projects; (7) improve intersection Level-of-Service using low-cost solutions; (8) reduce neighborhood “cut through” traffic; (9) expand transit services; (10) expand transit services for the elderly and the disabled; (11) increase transit ridership and farebox revenues; (12) coordinate transportation and land use decisions; (13) improve non-vehicular transportation; (14) include sidewalks and bikeways into the design of all non-limited access roadway projects; (15) provide for an energy efficient transportation system; (16) reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and, (17) advance a transportation network that promotes infill development.
