Healthy Community Zones

A Healthy Community Zone is an area where existing community resources and activities are connected to coordinated partnerships to improve a community's health.

Working together for a healthier Broward!










What is a Healthy Community Zone?

A Healthy Community Zone (HCZ) is a specific area where your existing community resources and activities can be connected into coordinated partnerships for improving community health.

Envisioning and designing improvements for your community in the four TOUCH Focus Areas




Ensuring that your community is recognized as a Healthy Community Zone and showcased at the National level

Healthy Community Zones Criteria

To become a designated Healthy Community Zone, the following five criteria must be met:



Targeted Area

A targeted community area in Broward County, with dimensions between 5 to 20 blocks in length



Middle or High School

A middle or high school
within the target area
with a Y-Program and a
Students Working
Against Tobacco
(SWAT) team [or
intentions to create a
SWAT team with these
students]



Areas with Health, Wealth & Educational Disparities

Above the County Rate:

- PreventableDiabetesHospitalizations;
- Poverty; and/or
- Educational
 Attainment



Focus Areas

- Tobacco-Free Living
- Healthy Eating and Active Living
- Healthy and Safe
 Built Environments
- Clinical and Community Linkages



Willingness to Partner

A willingness to partner with TOUCH, recognizing that there is no direct funding attached to being selected as a Healthy Community Zone

Communities with a current YMCA before- and after-school program will receive preference for HCZ designation.


How can people or communities apply?

Applicants must be open to partnering with TOUCH in all four strategic directions / focus areas (Active Living & Healthy Eating, Healthy & Safe Physical Environments, Community Linkages to Clinical Preventative Services, Tobacco Free Living)

February

TOUCH Partners began strategizing and organizing the HCZ Initiative



April 15 to June 1

Communities can apply to become HCZ via online RFP process



July

Healthy Community Zone fun begins!



March - May

TOUCH Partners perform outreach to educate communities about the HCZ opportunity



HCZ finalist and sites will be selected
